ADVERTISEMENT DATED 07/09/2017:

Applications are invited from the local residents of Tinsukia District in standard form along with two numbers of passport size photographs for selection of around 50 numbers of Para Legal Volunteers(PLV's), who are willing to serve as Para Legal Volunteers for the District of Tinsukia and also in the Sub-Divisions of Margherita and Sadiya under the District Legal Services Authority, Tinsukia. The applicants should fulfil the following criteria for selection as Para Legal Volunteer.

WHO CAN APPLY:

- (a) Teachers (including retired teachers)
- (b) Retired Government Servants and Senior Citizens;
- (c) M.S.W Students and Teachers;
- (d) Anganwadi Workers;
- (e) Doctors/ Physicians;
- (f) Students & Law Students (till they enrol as lawyers)
- (g) Members of Non-Political service oriented NGOs and Clubs
- (h) Members of Women Neighbourhood Groups, Maithri Sanghams and Other self help groups including marginalized and vulnerable groups.
- (i) Educated prisoners with good behaviour serving long term sentences in prisons;
- (j) Any other person whom the District Legal Services Authority deems fit to be identified as PLVs.

OTHER TERMS AND CONDITONS:

- 1) He/ She must be a citizen of India;
- 2) The applicant should pass minimum Matriculation with a capacity for overall comprehension and should have a mindset to assist the needy in society coupled with the compassion, empathy and concern for the upliftment of the marginalized and weaker sections of the society. They must have the unflinching commitment towards the cause which should be translated into the work they undertake;
- 3) The applicants should not be less than 18 years of age as on the date of the advertisement;
- 4) The applicant should mention their mobile phone number and email ID in the application form;
- 5) The applicant shall mention in the application form separately his place of preference of work at either District Level/ Taluk Level /Village Level;
- 6) The work of PLV does not carry salary, remuneration or wage except Honorarium fixed by the concerned authorities from time to time;

- 7) The filled up application forms should reach the Office of the District Legal Services Authority, Tinsukia, Mediation Centre, Tinsukia District Court Complex, P.O-Borguri,786126.
- 8) The last date for submission of filled up application is **22/09/2017**;
- 9) Incomplete applications will be rejected without assigning any reasons. No applications will be entertained after the last date fixed;
- 10) The decision of the Selection Committee in short listing the number of candidates for interview and selection of PLV shall be final. They will be selected as per relevant scheme in this regard;
- 11) The selected PLVs shall be required to undergo training programme from time to time as per directions of the District Legal Services Authority, Tinsukia;
- 12) In case of any objection regarding selection of PLVs, the decision of the Chairman, District Legal Services Authority, Tinsukia shall be final and binding to all concerned;
- 13) The list of shortlisted eligible candidates will be notified in the Official Notice Board as well as uploaded in the Official Website of Tinsukia District Judiciary, i.e <http://tinsukiajudiciary.gov.in> for interview.
- 14) Canvassing in any form, directly or indirectly shall lead to disqualification of the candidate.
- 15) No TA/DA will be provided for appearing in the interview;
- 16) The other terms and conditions of engagement of PLVs shall be governed by the Scheme for Para Legal Volunteers(Revised) and other such Schemes from time to time;
